## Adding a Hypothesis Activity

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1. Start by **turning editing on**, then click **"Add an activity or resource"** in the section you would like to add the activity to.



2. From the list of activities, click "External Tool" and add it to your course.



- 3. You can set the **Activity Name** to anything you'd like, this is what students would see and click on to access the activity.
- 4. Click the option for "**Preconfigured Tool**" to open a drop-down menu. From this menu, click the "**Hypothesis**" option.



5. Scroll down to the "**Restrictions**" heading and click on it.



6. Click "Add Restriction". From the options available, click "Grade" to set up a restriction based on the grade received from the consent form.

(**Note:** While it is basing the restriction off of a grade, the quiz itself should automatically be weighted as 0% and will not affect students grades if it was downloaded from this article. You can confirm that it is weighted as 0% by viewing your **Gradebook Setup**.)

7. Ensure your restriction is set up where students **Must match** a **Greater than or equal to** grade of **100** in the **Hypothesis Consent** quiz.

- 8. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click "Save and Return to course"
- 9. You should now see a restriction added to your Hypothesis activity on your main course page. You can verify whether students are restricted from using the activity by switching your role to a student and attempting to use it (Click your name in the top-right corner, Switch role to, Student).

10. Restrictions must be configured this way for each Hypothesis activity that is added to a course. The Hypothesis Consent quiz only needs to be added to a course once.
